






ANALOG CONNECTION:

HOW TO DETERMINE IF THE VEHICLE HAS ANALOG SWC:

Analog Steering Wheel Control (SWC) signal vehicles will have wires populated and line up to the PINK and BLACK wire on the 24-Pin Crux connector.

If one wire is missing then you will need to use Crux part number SWRFD-60.







3.5MM SWC CABLE

Plug in the 3.5MM to 4-Pin SWC cable to the SWC module.

NOTE: Insulate the Blue/Yellow and Green wires if not being used.

For aftermarket radios that have wires for SWC connections, cut off the 3.5mm plug on the Crux SWC Cable (option B) and connect the SWC wires as follows:

Note that there are some radios that only have SWC1 and SWC2, in this case "shield" does not need to be connected.



For all vehicles listed below, remove the shaded mounting tabs on both

- Insert ISO mountable radio between ISO mount brackets and loosely attach to sides Insert pocket into lower section of kit from rear & lock into slots of mounting brackets
- Slide radio forward or backward for desired look and tighten screws of radio using screws provided with radio when possible or screws supplied with kit.
- Attach a rear support bracket to the rear of the new radio and adjust as necessary to support the weight of the radio (Optional)



DOUBLE DIN MOUNT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Insert ISO mountable radio between ISO mount brackets and loosely attach to Attach left and right mounting brackets to the kit as shown in the figure below. or screws supplied with kit. sides of radio using screws provided with radio when possible
- Support the rear of the radio component with back strap (optional).

 Remove shaded tabs Slide radio forward or backward for desired look and tighten screws.

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






